## PRESCHOOL

Our Child Development Center provides balanced experiences rich in both academic and recreational learning following the Creative Curriculum. Nurturing, energetic professionals foster age appropriate growth of language, literacy, social, emotional and life skills.

**Preschool includes swim lessons, music & movement class, pee wee sports and time on the outdoor natural playground.**

Centers offer exploration with science and math labs. Individual expression in arts and dramatic play are fostered to create an atmosphere that helps develop each child's own unique style. Fine and gross motor skill experiences are integrated into all centers. Teachers emphasize caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Maximum ratio is 1:10. Contact Debbie Rose to learn more.

**Fees:** 3-4 year olds (potty trained): \$210 for 3 days a week  
4-5 year olds: \$210 for 3 days a week or \$325 for 5 days a week  
\$625 per month for Preschool (9am to 12pm) + Full-time Child Care (7am to 7pm)  
**This full time package includes a YMCA family membership.**



We are pleased to be state certified by the Oregon Child Care Division. Staff are background checked and participate in on-going training and education.

## CHILD CARE

Taught by Preschool staff, our Extended Child Care by the hour is designed to wrap around Preschool or stand alone. Our program is convenient for families needing as little as one hour per month as well as those who need full time care. Maximum ratio is 1:10.

**Fees:** \$3.75 per hour for 3-6 year olds (potty trained)  
\$625 per month for Full-time Child Care (7am to 7pm)  
**This package includes a YMCA family membership.**

## AFTERSCHOOL

We offer a family-centered program for kids on-site at local elementary schools. Youth learn the values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility from positive role models. The Y partners with parents and school personnel to provide age appropriate activities that foster social skills and decision making. We pair academic support with fun and exciting activities that build healthy, happy kids.

**Afterschool includes homework assistance, snack, organized gym games, art, science and outdoor group activities.**

Staff engage children in a variety of ways so kids will learn, grow and thrive. We strive to balance the unique needs of each individual child. Maximum ratio is 1:15. Contact Michele Hunt to learn more.

**Fees:** Lots of monthly options, see price sheet.  
(program runs from school dismissal to 6:00pm)

Also, single day options available for school in-service days, holidays, breaks and summer.  
(7:30am to 6:00pm)

## DAY CAMP

Day camp is a fast paced and exciting atmosphere that will keep your camper engaged while school is out. Camp is safe, fun and affordable with weekly themes.

**Day camp includes weekly field trips, fun activities, swimming, snack, songs and time in the outdoors.**

Day camp is offered when the local school districts let out for Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break, Spring Break and Summer. Maximum ratio is 1:15. Contact Gary Taylor to learn more.

**Fees:** \$25 per day for youth (7:30am to 6:00pm)
