



Rock Climbing Camp 2020



I am so excited to get outside and go rock climbing with your campers next week. As a result of the COVID-19 mitigation regulations we will need to modify this camp from an overnight experience to a day ONLY program. In addition to this we will not be able to provide bused transportation. Families will be asked to get their camper to the drop off and pick up locations, each day. We know this may be more driving for you but in order to follow the social distancing guidelines this will be required (if you are unable to participate because of this please talk to me as soon as possible). The YMCA will be providing lunch each day so families do not need to worry about packing a lunch, just a full water bottle and items listed below (due to COVID-19 there are not drinking fountains available). If your camper has any special food issues please contact Gary Taylor so that we can plan all lunches accordingly. All climbing and safety equipment will be provided by the YMCA. This entire camp will be over seen by YMCA staff.

We will spend the first day at the YMCA facility using the climbing gym to get all campers trained and ready for the next two days of climbing at Emigrant Lake County Park. When you arrive at Emigrant Lake County Park please note there is no need for you to pay the day use fee as long as you are just picking up and dropping off your camper. In order to help with the required social distancing we will locate a spot at the park that will hopefully allow for drive thru pick-up and drop-off so parents will not even need to get out of their vehicles.
